



Ibstock - Arden Weathered Red Multi Brick. This brick has been used on the bay adjacent 'Whetherley Court' to help relate surrounding context. With the brick being used on both the rest of the building & View Road then it allows for a distinct link between both entrances to the building.



Parapet Coping Stone - Portland Colour. A material that emphasises the idea of both quality design & a quality palette of materials.



Dark Grey Aluminium Window System - RAL 7021. The use of this window system helps to define the georgian window proportions utilised within the design. It also gives the impression of high quality materials.



White Render with ashlar cut detailing. The render helps to break up the 3 bays and emphasis the vertical element of the North Hill frontage. Helps to establish the bays as individual elements whilst also outlining that the width of the bays relates to the width of the listed terraces.



Forterra - Belgravia Gaunt Blend Brick. A buff brick that avoids replicating the material on the adjacent listed terraces (109 - 119 North Hill) but rather looks to find a balance between both the buff & red brick that forms part of the North Hill streetscape.
