Re: application no. HGY/2011/1394 – 8 Causton Road N6 5ES

I am writing on behalf of the Highgate Society regarding the above application for a loft conversion to a semi-detached residence with wide rear dormer and three velux windows to the roof facing the street.

The Highgate Society has several concerns with the proposals:

1. The three proposed velux windows on the roof facing the street would be visible from the pavement and have an impact on the Conservation Area. It is unclear what type of velux window is proposed, and whether these would be mounted so as to be nearly flush with the surrounding roof tiles.
2. The proposed rear dormer is of a scale that has precedence on adjacent properties. However the large size overwhelms the rear roof and is generally out of proportion with the rear elevation.
3. The rear dormer has potential overlooking issues and neighbour's views should be sought in this regard.

In view of the above, the Highgate Society objects to this application.
