Comments: I only moved into the area recently but Abbots Terrace was one of the elements of the local area that was so appealing. It is a rural road with a character that is rare in London. I tend to walk to and from the amenities of Crouch End via Abbots Terrace to enjoy its charms, even though it takes a little longer. Friends who visit the area are quick to comment on how special it is. Given the location is within a conservation area, the resurfacing of Abbots Terrace and lighting in the manner set out in the application would constitute a failure to preserve or enhance the area's special character. In addition, the increased traffic would risk displacing wildlife in the area. A change in the lighting and road infrastructure on Abbots Terrace also risks unintended consequences, such as increasing antisocial behaviour. This would have a devastating impact upon the local community. I strongly support the objections that have been made to this application.
