Submission: Objection

Comments: This is the most recent in a long series of applications which have caused considerable distress and apprehension to those most affected, particularly the residents of Abbot's Terrace, a narrow lane whose houses immediately abutt what would be an access road to the proposed development. The principal objection is based on the nuisance that would be caused by an increase in traffic in a narrow, quite unsuitable route, especially during the building phase but also thereafter, which would introduce unwelcome physical and noise pollution. It is evident that a significant number of the residents in the immediate area are more than unhappy about what is proposed, and that the Council has recognised and upheld their case in the past. It is difficult to see what has changed since the last time the plans were turned down and I would strongly support the objections that have been made to the new application.
