Submission: Objection

Comments: We strongly object to the proposal to build a dwelling on the REAR of 29 Haringey Park..including access via Abbots Terrace.

- this is not a new proposal but one which has already been rejected a number of times. He is now proposing to tarmac the lane and adding lighting but no mention of how this will be maintained in the future.
- we still have the issue of lane access with very large vehicles with no room for error (2.4m wide vehicle in 2.9m lane). Including unknown structural damage. Safety issues given the lane is used by the residents (many of them elderly) and children for play and school/nursery route.
- the lane is in a Conservation area and still has a semi rural feel to it and used for walks by many people and any change to it would destroy another green part of Crouch End.
- our house is on the corner of abbots terrace and the corner frequently 'clipped' by medium sized vehicles turning into the lane and I fear the larger vehicles will cause even more damage.

On a more personal note, the constant re application is causing undue stress to the many elderly residents who live in the houses on Abbots Terrace.
