NOTIFICATION UNDER THE ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS CODE (CONDITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS) REGULATIONS 2003 (AS AMENDED) TO UTILISE PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT RIGHTS AT REF 8812978, STREET LAMP, 263, SEVEN SISTERS ROAD, STROUD GREEN, LONDON, N4 2DE (NGR: 531475, 186803)

Please accept this letter and its enclosures as formal notification in writing of 28 days' notice in advance, in accordance with Regulation 5 of the Electronic Communications Code (Conditions and Restrictions) Regulations 2003 (as amended).

No fee is required for this notification.

BT Wholesale on behalf of EE UK Ltd (Everything Everywhere) intend to utilise their permitted development rights as defined in Part 16 of Schedule 2 of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 (as amended)

The proposals contained herein constitute permitted development under Class A of Part 16.

The proposal is to install electronic communications apparatus/development ancillary to the existing unit on behalf of BT Wholesale on behalf of EE UK Ltd (Everything Everywhere).

For the avoidance of doubt this letter does not constitute:

- An application for a determination as to whether the prior approval of the Authority will be required to siting and appearance; or
- An application for planning permission.

The proposed installation comprises:

- The installation of 1 no. 4G/5G small cell antenna upon the existing Street Lamp unit.
- The installation of 2 no. radio units upon the existing Street Lamp unit.
- The installation of 1 no. BBU unit upon the existing Street Lamp unit.
- The installation of associated ancillary equipment.

The antenna is to provide 4G/5G infill services to the area, situated upon units being leased off the TFL already agreed in a contract separate to the enclosed Regulation 5 notification. The antennas are small cells, offering the most minimal design solution possible. This ensures that the visual impact of the development on the surrounding area has been minimised so far as practicable

It will be located as marked on the attached drawings at:

STREET LAMP, 263, SEVEN SISTERS ROAD, STROUD GREEN, LONDON, N4 2DE (NGR: 531475, 186803)

It will deliver public benefit in terms of the mobile services it will provide.
